BHS Cheer Tryout Clinics

- Clinics to prepare for tryouts will be held Monday, March 8th - Thursday March 11th
 - Monday - Wednesday: 6:00-7:30pm (learning tryout material, practicing)
 - Thursday: 6:00-8:00pm (Mock Tryouts, allow the girls to run through routines)
- Girls must attend at least one clinic on Monday or Tuesday to learn applicable tryout material
- Girls can be dropped off at the back of the old gymnasium

Updates to Constitution

- An incoming senior who has had 3 consecutive years with the BHS Cheer program and has maintained good standing will be automatically placed on the Varsity squad.** Although those wanting Captain must tryout for the judges score component.**
- Eligibility (Mr. Hollomon)
- Cheerleaders/mascot will be selected by 70% judges (outside and impartial) , 15% teacher evaluation, and 15% school spirit resume. Tryouts will be held in a closed session. Incoming 9th grade candidates are only eligible for the JV squad. Incoming 12th grade candidates are only eligible for Varsity. The natural break method will be used for tryouts. The natural break is defined as the obvious place in the scores where a numerical difference occurs. Scores will be ranked numerically with the first natural break identifying the Varsity squad followed by the 2nd natural break designating the JV Squad. The Varsity squad will consist of no more than 16 and JV Squad will consist of no more than 12. Students who are presently in 8th, 9th, 10th, and 11th are eligible for mascot.

Constitution Updates Cont.

- Tryout paperwork and initial payment of \$200 is due Friday, March 5th. (Checks will be returned to those who are not selected for the squad) Paperwork includes: Cheerleader Application, Parent/Student Cheer Constitution Acknowledgement, Extracurricular Standards of Behavior Contract, Emergency Care and Permission for Treatment, and Concussion Acknowledgement.
- The remaining expense for camp will be due April 16th.
- Uniform and camp clothes expenses will be paid directly to Varsity.
- Two fundraisers will be scheduled and all cheerleaders and mascot will be required to participate.

Constitution updates cont.

- After school practices can be scheduled twice a week on Mondays from 5:45-7:45 and Wednesdays from 5:30-7:30pm during the fall season. (ending time is subject to change, prior notice will be given.) *An additional practice may be added to the week to prepare for an important game or event (this is usually the case during playoffs since there will be community pep rallies and schedules can not be predicted.)* Each squad member should arrive on time with the right attire on and ready to practice.
- Assuming that the daily schedule of BHS remains the same, there will be a required practice on Friday mornings from 7:30am-8:45am (encompassing flex class) throughout the fall and spring semesters.

Fundraisers

- Two fundraisers will be scheduled and all cheerleaders and mascot will be required to participate.
 - Fall Fundraiser: Turkey Trot (Wednesday before Thanksgiving)
 - Spring Fundraiser: Drive Thru Dinner (April or May)
