


District Goals

Northwest Early College High School Goals for Student Achievement

- Students earn their associate degree and high school diploma simultaneously.
- All students will pass the EOC exams on the first attempt. Northwest ECHS will continue to improve the number of students earning masters (Last year ELA I 20% to 25%, ELA II 25% to 30%, Algebra I 34 to 39%, Biology 50% to 55%, US History 61% to 66%).
- NWECHS will retain 95% of our 110 incoming freshmen C/2026 (from freshman to sophomore year).
- By May 2023, all students in the class of 2026 will have passed the ELA TSI 2.0. All students enrolled in Algebra II will have passed the math TSI.
