

STUDENTSParent/Guardian and Student Rights in Administration of Surveys, Analysis or Evaluations

All instructional materials, including supplementary materials and teachers' manuals, used with any survey, analysis or evaluation in a program or project supported by federal funds are available for inspection by parents and guardians.

No student will be required as part of any project or program supported by federal funds to submit to survey, analysis or evaluation that reveals information concerning the following without prior written consent of the student, if the student is an adult or an emancipated minor, or the student's parent/guardian:

1. Political affiliations or beliefs of the student or of the student's parent/guardian;
2. Mental or psychological problems of the student or the student's family;
3. Sexual behavior and attitudes;
4. Illegal, anti-social, self-incriminating or demeaning behavior;
5. Critical appraisals of other individuals with whom the student has close family relationships;
6. Legally recognized privileged or analogous relationships, such as those of lawyers, physicians, ministers;
7. Religious practices, affiliations, or beliefs of the student or student's parent/guardian; or
8. Income other than that required by law to determine eligibility for participation in a program or for receiving financial assistance under such program.

The district will protect student privacy during the administration of surveys and the collection, disclosure or use of personal information for marketing, sales or other distribution purposes.

The superintendent or designee will develop procedures consistent with this policy.
