



Things to know about changes to Washington Apple Health (Medicaid)

in Jefferson and Kitsap counties

Changes are coming January 1, 2020 to Apple Health

*This change **will not reduce any benefits**. Apple Health (Medicaid) clients will continue to have access to all of the same services they currently do, but the state will pay for them differently.*

What's changing

Three Apple Health plans will be available in your county:

- Amerigroup
- Molina Healthcare
- United Healthcare

Clients that are already enrolled in one of these plans don't need to do anything.

These plans cover mental health and substance use disorder treatment services. For individuals who also have Medicare, this applies to behavioral health only.

Two plans will not be available:

- Community Health Plan of Washington
- *Coordinated Care

Clients enrolled in one of these two plans will be switched to one of the three available plans. The change will be automatic so that no one loses coverage.

You will get a letter in December with the name of the health plan that will cover your services beginning January 1. You will have the option to change plans. The letter will explain how to do this.
