



## OCEAN K-12 Family Partnership Program

### K- 8 Expectations and Information

#### **Curriculum/Partnership**

- Teachers will provide curriculum materials and monthly learning expectations.
- Families are the primary at home teachers work in partnership with OCEAN teachers.
- Learning is individualized by families and teachers for each child's level.
- Learning plans and student work are reviewed each month at the family conference to develop a plan for the following month.

#### **Google Classroom**

- Google Classroom is a tool for communicating activities, monthly learning expectations, assignments, and ideas for you to work on with your child.
- Student work is typically turned in directly to the teacher in person, not in Google Classroom.

#### **Shared Google Folder for Each Student Option**

- Each student will have an option for a shared Google Folder that digital work can be turned into to share with the conferencing teacher.
- One way families can share the wide variety of learning students are doing away from school is the shared google folder.
- Students and families can include photos, videos, work samples, or anything that they want to share with the conferencing teacher during monthly conferences.

#### **Student Learning Plans and Monthly Conferences**

- Written Student Learning Plans (WSLPs) are written at the beginning of the year.
- They are updated monthly by parents and teachers during conferences.
- A hard copy is placed in each child's file.
- Parents, students and teachers will meet once a month to review work, goals and set new goals.

#### **Timesheets/activity log and paperwork**

An essential way to share how much learning you are doing. Our program and funding depends on you getting this paperwork in each month. This is the minimum number of hours required on the K-8 activity log is 28 hours spread out in the following way:

- Language Arts- 5 hours weekly
- Social Studies- 5 hours weekly
- Science- 5 hours weekly
- Math- 5 hours weekly
- Health Fitness- 4 hours weekly
- Art- 4 hours weekly
