I. NJASK (3rd – 5th Grades) or Terra Nova (2nd Grade) Score:

- Student scores Advanced Proficient in ALL areas 4 pts.
- Student scores Advanced Proficient in 2 Subjects (Grade 4)
OR in 1 Subject (Grades 2, 3, and 5) 2 pts.

II. OLSAT (Ottis Lennon School Ability Test)

- Student receives a School Ability Index (SAI) of 130 or above Automatically Qualified
- Student receives a School Ability Index (SAI) of 125 or above
and a National Grade Percentile Rank between 8-9 2 pts.
- Student receives a School Ability Index (SAI) of 120 or above
and a National Grade Percentile Rank between 8-9 1 pt.

III. Renzulli-Hartman Scale (Teacher Evaluation)

- Total score between 148-132 (Grades 4-5, Math/LA teachers averaged) 2 pts.
- Total score between 131-108 (Grades 4-5, Math/LA teachers averaged) 1 pt.
