Principal's Report - Mr. Tom McGuire

PRE-K PARENT NIGHT/NEW STUDENT ROUND-UP

- Both evenings went well.
- Cap placed on PK3/4 due to max amount of students. Wait list to start. Some exceptions could possibly be made if both the teacher and Mr. McGuire agree upon an additional student. The exception would also be made based on the days during the week that are available for an additional student.

ENROLLMENT GROWTH

- Enrollment continues to grow. We have exceeded 200 students! We currently have 204 with the strong possibility of meeting or exceeding 210 by months end. We have seen a 29% increase since 8/1/14 for K-8 and a 53.5% increase for PK-8 for same time period.

SUPPORT STAFF

- We have brought on additional staff to meet the needs of our growing school. K welcomed Ms. Filippo, 1st welcomed Ms. Stathius, 2nd welcomed Ms. Fenimore and 3rd welcomed Ms. Player. Additionally, the middle school welcomed Mrs. Laricks for 6/7th reading and writing and 7th grade social studies.
- Mrs. Pasceri will provide additional speech/language support for our Pre-School.
- Betsy Filippo will be 2 days a week as an overflow assistant.
- Jeff LaFrance will be providing small group instruction 1 day a week in the morning, 2 hours a week as business support, and also be assisting with special projects as it relates to the grounds and building.

VISION 20/20

- 20 people have worked almost 1 full year on Vision 20/20, the team consists of 5 sub committees.
- Vision 20/20 will be rolled out at Back to School Night. Vision 20/20 looks at a strategic plan for both short and long term as it relates to the future of our school.
