Parent Code of Conduct

1. Have respect for all volunteer coaches, team members, opponents, officials and other representatives involved in The League of Champions. **Parents/guardians are not allowed to confront a coach, team, player, parent/guardian, official, coordinator, or director to discuss any "negative" game or practice situation(s) until at least 24 hours has passed from the completion of the game or practice.**
2. Agree to support our team in a positive manner and showcase good sportsmanship toward all players, coaches, parents, and game officials
3. Ensure that my child takes proper care of all equipment that is issued and/or placed at a gym or field.
4. Immediately notify a coach if equipment becomes damaged.
5. Immediately notify the coach if my child will be absent from practice.
6. Make sure my child is picked up on time after practices or games, or contact the coach as soon as possible if I cannot.
7. Ensure that my child knows and understands that Sportsmanship and Teamwork are mandatory; **no vulgar language, tantrums, displays of anger, or fighting will be tolerated.**
8. Respect the coaches' commitment to coach my child and will not interfere with on-field instruction during practices or games
9. Ensure that my child represents him/herself and teammates on and off the field and/or gym.
10. Teach my child to play by the rules and respect teammates, opponents, game officials, and coaches
11. Make sure whether in victory or defeat my child conducts him/herself with pride and poise.
12. Ensure that my child knows and understands that he/she is a player for Portales-Roosevelt County Youth Sports and that the game is measured by the development of skills, not by winning or losing.
13. I will cheer for our team in a positive manner no matter the outcome of the game
14. Talk to the League Coordinator or Contact the League Director, if there is a concern.

Athlete Code of Conduct

1. Have respect for all **volunteer coaches**, team members, opponents, officials and other representatives involved in Portales-Roosevelt County Youth Sports League of Champions.
2. Take proper care of all equipment that is issued and/or placed at a gym or field.
3. I will honor the sport by playing within the rules during games and practices.
4. Immediately notify my coach if I will be absent from practice.
5. I will remember that Sportsmanship and Teamwork are mandatory. **No vulgar language, tantrums, displays of anger, or fighting will be tolerated.**
6. I am accountable for the results of my behavior toward my teammates, coaches and game officials.
7. Represent myself and teammates positively on and off the field and/or gym.
8. Conduct myself with pride and poise, whether in victory or defeat.
9. When I make a great play, I will not embarrass my opponent.
10. Remember that I am a player for Portales-Roosevelt County Youth Sports League of Champions and that the game is measured by the development of skills, not by winning or losing.
11. Agree to put my team first and put forth my best effort on the field in support of team goals.
12. Talk to the League Coordinator or Contact the League Director, if there is a concern.

The Portales-Roosevelt County Youth Sports League of Champions' goal is for children to have the opportunity to participate in sports and other activities outside of the school day. The primary objective of after-school sports is to teach children the fundamentals and skills of their chosen sport, sports, or activities. The League of Champions wishes to expand on helping children learn to play a sport or participate in an activity, develop self-confidence and positive self-reflection, learn the importance of teamwork, and develop positive character traits. Although winning is important, the League of Champions values children learning how to win with grace and lose with dignity. The expectation is that parents, guardians, relatives, and fans will act accordingly while attending games and practice and will support the League, its coordinators, coaches, officials, and volunteers in instilling these values.

I/we understand that no Code of Conduct can foresee or encompass all situations. The League Coordinator or Director may address situations not addressed in the Code of Conduct or sporting event rules that cause a disruption to a game or practice or may cause harm to any player, official, fan, or coach. Violations to the Code of Conduct or sporting event rules may result in sanctions to the offending player or fan. Any player or fan who is ejected from a game will not be allowed to participate or attend future games or events until successful completion of either the *Sportsmanship* or *Positive Parenting Within School Programs* courses through the New Mexico Activities Association. I/we further understand that a subsequent ejection will result in being barred from attending any game or event for the remainder of the season.

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HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

IMPORTANT: This agreement contains a waiver of rights by the people signing it. Please READ IT CAREFULLY. If you have any questions or reservations about it whatsoever, please do not sign it.

This AGREEMENT entered into this ___ day of _____, 20___ by and between the Portales Municipal School District, and _____ (the "Participant"), or _____ and _____ (the "Parent(s) of the Participant" if he or she is under the age of 18 years.)

WITNESSETH: In consideration of the Participant being allowed by Portales Municipal School District to participate in all Portales Municipal School District League of Champions recreation programs and in consideration of the covenants and representations herein made, the Participant or the Parent(s) of the Participant do hereby agree as follows:

1. The Participant or the Parent(s) of the Participant as the case may be, do hereby release and discharge and agree to hold harmless the Portales Municipal School District (hereinafter the "PMSD"), its Board members, agents, employees, volunteers, and assigns and the City of Portales, its agents and assigns, individually and collectively of and from any and all liability, actions, causes of action, claims, damages, demands and responsibility whatsoever in law and in equity, including attorneys' fees and costs, arising out of or relating to any loss, damage or injury, including death, the Participant participating in the Program may sustain, or being a passenger in a vehicle provided by PMSD, in conjunction with the Program unless the same is caused by the gross negligence or willful misconduct of PMSD, if such claims are permitted under the New Mexico Tort Claims Act.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, any liability incurred by PMSD in connection with this Agreement shall be subject to the immunities and limitations of the New Mexico Tort Claims Act, Section 41-4-1, et. seq. NMSA 1978, as amended. PMSD and its "public employees," as defined in the New Mexico Tort Claims Act, do not waive sovereign immunity, do not waive any defense, and do not waive any limitation of liability pursuant to law. No provision in this Agreement shall modify or waive any provision of the New Mexico Tort Claims Act.

2. The Participant or the Parent(s) of the Participant specifically acknowledge the potential of risk and injury involved in participation in the Program and do hereby assume said risk and authorize PMSD or its representative to obtain emergency medical treatment for the Participant should the same be necessary during the course of the Program and should PMSD or its representative be unable to make immediate contact with the Parent(s) of the Participant. The Participant or the Parent(s) shall be responsible for the costs of said emergency treatment.

3. It is understood and agreed that PMSD, shall not be required to maintain medical or hospitalization insurance coverage with respect to the program and those who participate in it.
