In addition to the labor laws, the Lake Tahoe Unified School District has established minimum requirements that students must meet to obtain a work permit. Please review the following items and initial the appropriate space below to indicate that you have read and understand these requirements.

- **Student must maintain a 2.0 GPA**
- **Student must maintain an overall attendance rate of 85%**
- **Student cannot have a failing grade on any report card**
- **Student must comply with all school rules**
- **Student will not be excused from Saturday school due to a work schedule conflict.**

According to federal law, the school **must** revoke work permits if the employment of the student is impairing the education of the minor. The school will monitor GPA's, attendance and grades at each grade reporting period throughout the school year.

On a case-by-case basis, the Superintendent or designee may approve a maximum work hour limit that is lower than the limit specified in law and administrative regulation.

If a student fails to meet the above stated requirements, his/her work permit will be revoked or suspended. *Students whose permits are revoked may reapply for a new permit if they meet the above criteria at the next grade reporting period.*
