2.

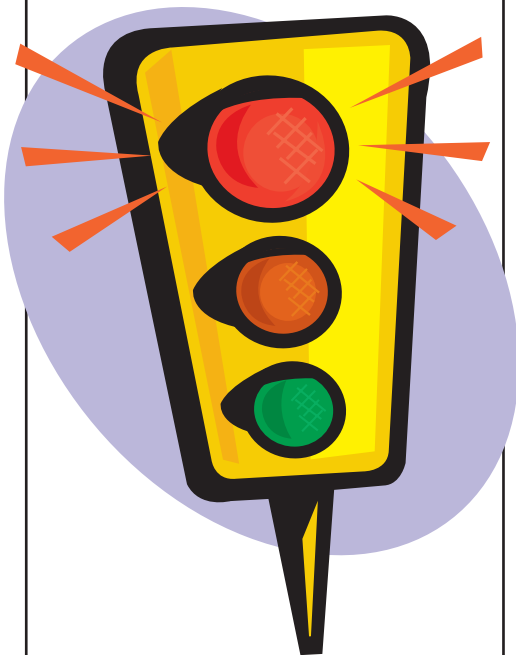
All students will demonstrate an understanding that our country is represented by symbols and icons such as flags, the bald eagle and coins/currency

All students will demonstrate that people work in many different jobs

- describe and chart school's layout and understand the jobs people do there
- describe and chart the local community and understand the jobs people do there.

All students will demonstrate an understanding that maps and models represent physical environments

- know address and phone number
- identify relative location (near/far, left/right, behind/in front)

- identify traffic symbols
- construct map/model of school/community
- demonstrate familiarity with school environs.

All students will demonstrate an awareness that events take place in a sequential order

- understand concepts of yesterday, today, tomorrow; daily schedule; days of the week.

All students will demonstrate an understanding that history relates to events, people and places of other times

- understand history and the meaning of holidays

- identify important historical figures
- compare living today with long ago.
