**22/23 Revised Dress Code**

As you prepare for the 2022-23 school year, the dress code will mirror this past year's dress code- uniforms are optional. As a reminder, students may wear any color shirts as well as shirts without collars. Shirts may include school appropriate logos, graphics, and/or wording. Students may wear jeans, joggers, sweatpants, shorts, and leggings in any color. They may also wear skirts, skorts, and dresses.

**Student Tops**

1. Shirts do not need to have a collar.
2. Shirts may have appropriate writing or graphics on them. Brand name logos are allowable.
3. Shirts may have patterns.
4. Shirts can be any color.

**Student Bottoms**

1. Jeans, sweatpants, leggings, and joggers in any color are allowed.
2. Pants may have no tears where skin can be seen behind the material. No mesh pants or mesh material.
3. Bottoms should be no more than 4" above the kneecap.

**Dresses**

1. Dresses are allowed but must be the appropriate length. (no higher than 4 inches above the kneecap.)

**Physical Education**

1. Sweatpants or Gym Shorts of any color are allowed this year.
  - a. Shorts should be no more than 4" above the kneecap.
2. Students must use the required Pine Hill PE Shirts.
