



Clearview Regional Community Members:

At our most recent board meeting, we approved a new activity participation fee policy, effective for the upcoming 2022-23 school year. This policy requires students who are members of Athletic teams/ Cheerleaders (all levels), or clubs receiving a “varsity letter” such as, Robotics, Chess or Marching Band, to pay \$75 per season, while an activity transportation fee of \$25 will apply to co-curricular clubs who compete with other schools, such as Model UN, DECA, TSA, etc.

Clearview Regional strongly believes in the value of athletic competition and co-curricular activities, and for this reason, feels it is necessary to take all measurable steps to maintain all of our district sponsored activities. These activity fees will preserve our programs for our students.

In the past few years, many surrounding districts have been forced to implement this type of policy. Despite consideration for this policy in the past, Clearview Regional was able to secure the necessary funding to absorb these costs. However, the current financial environment precludes us from doing so this year.

The revenue from the participation fees will be used to offset operating costs including: transportation, equipment, maintenance, insurance, officials, event registration fees, and other expenses incurred by the district in the operation of the activity.

Please note the activity fee will be waived or reduced based on financial hardship determined by using the New Jersey eligibility standards established for free and reduced priced meals. An approved lunch application for the 2022-23 school year must be on file to make this determination.

Fees will not be due until the rosters are finalized prior to the start of the season. Additional details will be provided on the Athletics/Activities website prior to the start of the school year.
