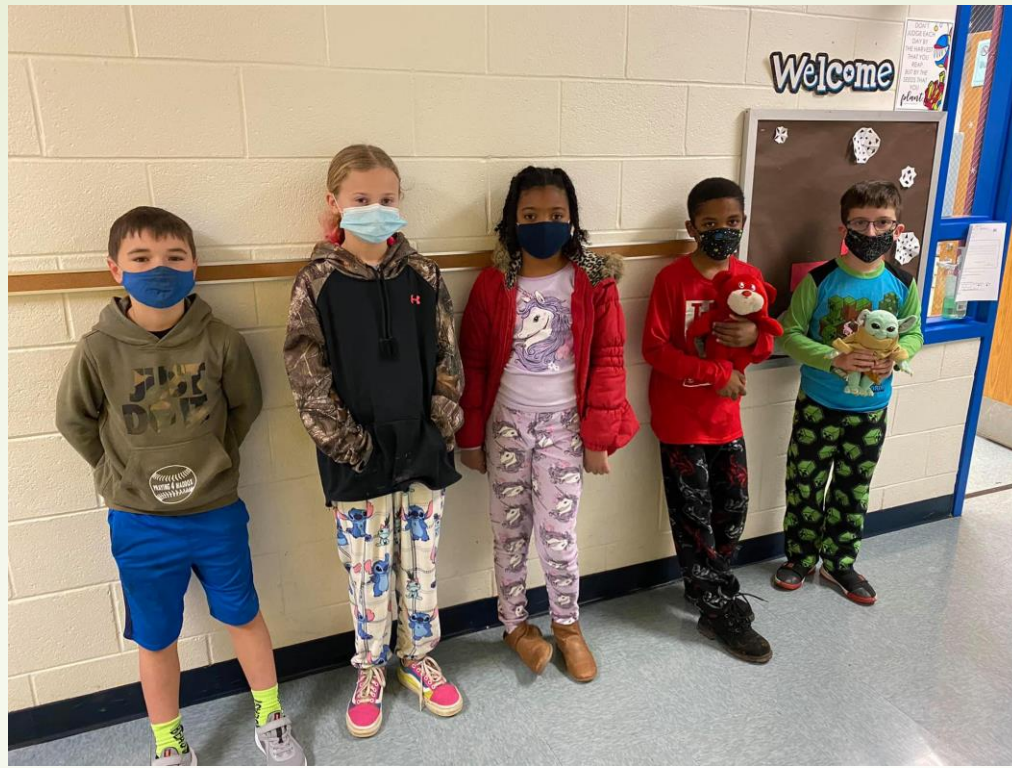

# Title III, Part A Grant- Overview

- Provides supplemental services to improve the English language proficiency and academic achievement of EL students.
- Provides afterschool tutoring support for EL students centered on language acquisition.
- Provides funding to purchase supplemental books and novel sets to support secondary level literacy (grades 6-12) for EL students.
- Provides funding to purchase materials and supplies in support of afterschool tutoring services.



# Measurable Objectives

# Title II, Part A -Measurable Objectives

- By June 2022, 75% of elementary students will either be reading on grade level or will have made at least a 10% growth in reading achievement from Fall 2021 to Spring 2022, as measured by PALS and/or NWEA MAP assessment data.
- By June 2022, all EL students will demonstrate at least a 20% increase in their WIDA score from the 2020-2021 school year.
