Out-of-District Attendance Areas

A child may attend a pre-kindergarten through grade one school in an attendance area other than the one which has been designated for him/her provided that:

- a. Transfer is authorized by the Superintendent who may seek recommendations of the professional staff.
- b. Approval is granted by the Superintendent upon the written request of the parent/guardian when it can be demonstrated that remaining in his/her own school would be detrimental to the best interest of the child. The parent/guardian will be responsible for transportation, unless otherwise specified by a Planning and Placement Team decision.
